The course contents are related to those UN Sustainable Development Goals that support equal access to information and energy efficiency.

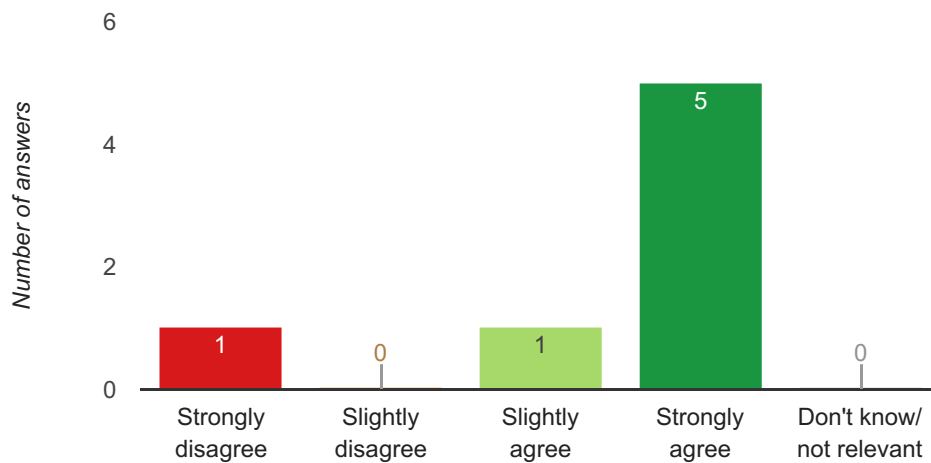
Learning objectives

- be able to evaluate retrieved information (e.g. relevance judgement, recall and precision)

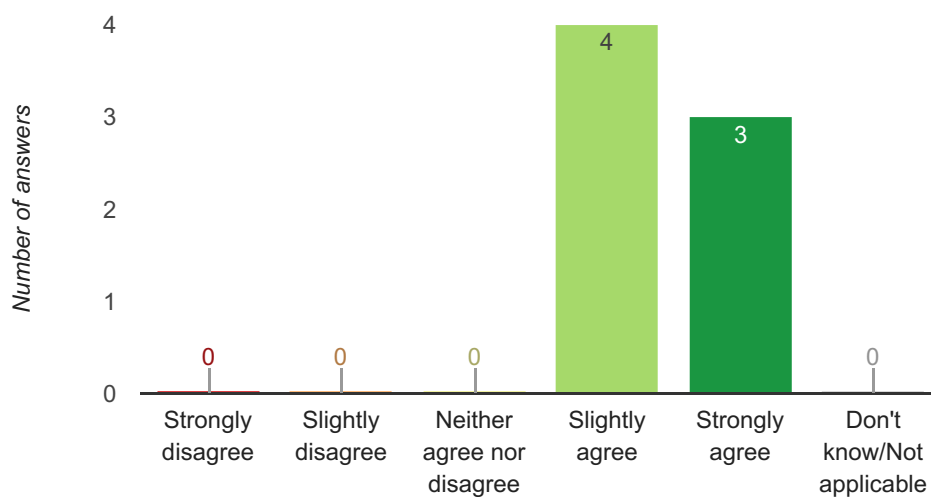

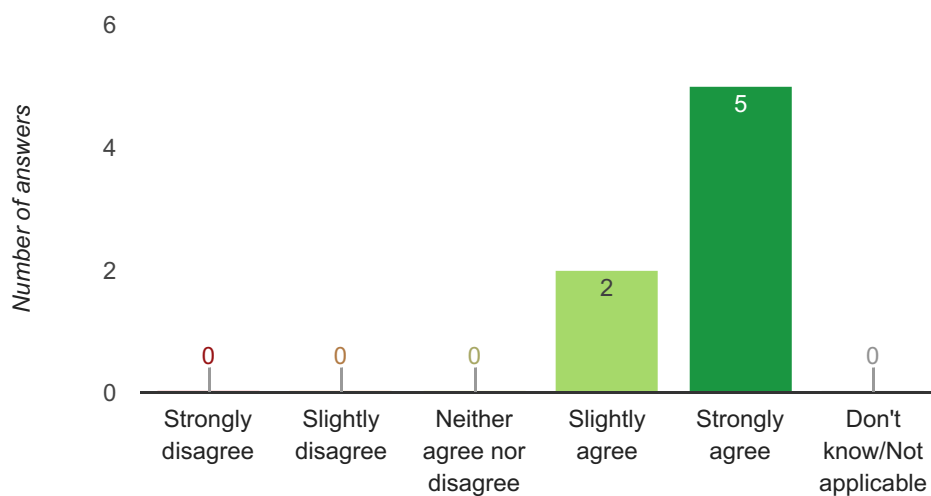

2. I would recommend the course to other students



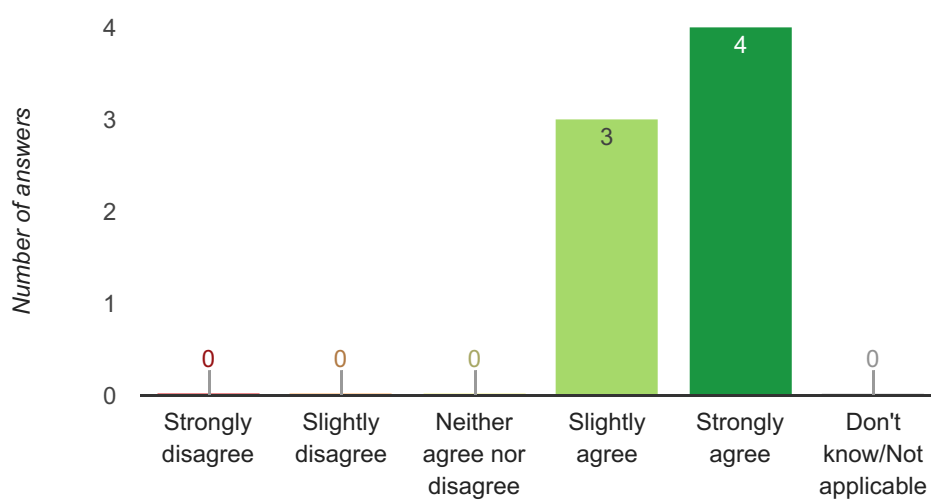
